


## American Dental Assistants Association Continuing Education (CE) Web Site (10/07)

The American Dental Assistants Association (ADAA) offers CE courses for dental assistants. One of these courses entitled, Digital Radiography in Dentistry: Moving from Film-Based to Digital Imaging, offers enlisted AF dental technicians the opportunity to complete a didactic course providing a knowledge base and facilitating further training for the eventual transition from conventional to digital radiology.
