

LIST OF CLINICAL PRIVILEGES – AIR RESERVE COMPONENTS (UTA) – ALLIED HEALTH

AUTHORITY: Title 10, U.S.C. Chapter 55, Sections 1094 and 1102.

PRINCIPAL PURPOSE: To define the scope and limits of practice for individual providers. Privileges are based on evaluation of the individual's credentials and performance.

ROUTINE USE: Information on this form may be released to government boards or agencies, or to professional societies or organizations, if needed to license or monitor professional standards of health care providers. It may also be released to civilian medical institutions or organizations where the provider is applying for staff privileges during or after separating from the Air Force.

DISCLOSURE IS VOLUNTARY: However, failure to provide information may result in the limitation or termination of clinical privileges.

INSTRUCTIONS

APPLICANT: In Part I, enter Code 1, 2, or 4 in each REQUESTED block for every privilege listed. This is to reflect your current capability. Sign, date and forward to your Clinical Supervisor.

CLINICAL SUPERVISOR: In Part I, using the facility master privileges list, enter Code 1, 2, or 4 in each VERIFIED block in response to each requested privilege. In Part II, check appropriate block either to recommend approval, to recommend approval with modification, or to recommend disapproval. Sign, date and forward the form to the Credentials Office.

CODES: 1. Fully competent within defined scope of practice.

2. Supervision required. (Unlicensed/uncertified or lacks current relevant clinical experience.)

3. Not approved due to lack of facility support. (Reference facility master Strawman. Use of this code is reserved for the Credentials Function.)

4. Not requested/not approved due to lack of expertise or proficiency, or due to physical disability or limitation.

CHANGES: Any change to a verified/approved privileges list must be made in accordance with Service Specific Credentialing and Privileging Policy.

Providers will order appropriate laboratory and diagnostic studies and refer to member's private health care provider for treatment and follow-up. Providers will take, evaluate and record comprehensive medical histories. Optometrists performs optometric exams, orders and administers medications for cycloplegic exams IAW AFI 48-123.

AF Reserve DPH Clinical Social Workers (UTA Only): Scope		Requested	Verified
P389058	The scope of privileges in clinical social work includes evaluation, diagnosis, treatment and consultation for patients with psychological disorders. Social workers apply clinical social work techniques for the purpose of understanding, preventing, and relieving psychological-based distress or dysfunction and to promote subjective well-being and personal development. They determine risk for harm, fitness/suitability for duty, and suitability for special assignments. Providers work with individuals of all ages, couples, families, groups and communities. Clinical social workers provide comprehensive behavioral health services in multiple settings including, clinic, inpatient, family advocacy programs, substance abuse treatment programs, and Service specific programs such as combat stress teams.
