SUBJECT: Implementation of MEDIC-X policy and implementation for all Air Force Medical Service uniformed members

After thorough coordination with the AFMS Corps Chiefs, CFMs, and Consultants, this memorandum provides formal guidance and instruction of MEDIC-X for the Air Force Medical Service (AFMS).

The MEDIC-X curriculum and training aligns with the Surgeon General's strategic initiative to develop a standardized medical force with broad skills common to all medical specialties as necessary to enhance and improve patient care outcoms in contested environments. All Air Force Medics can access additional video training via the secure MEDIC-X Knowledge Exchange (KX) website at https://kx.health.mil/kj/kx2/MedicX/Pages/home.aspx.

Group Commanders will ensure all Regular and Air Reserve Component medics, officers and enlisted, adhere to the MEDIC-X policy and training in accordance with the MEDIC-X Implementation Training Plan.

The MEDIC-X team will be hosting question and answer sessions for the first 90 days via MS Teams. The first session will be on 27 April 2023 (link to be provided on the KX website listed above).
